Mandatory pieces:

- W.A. Mozart: Bassoon concerto in Bb major, K. 191, 1st and 2nd movements (with cadenza)
- C. Saint-Saëns: Bassoon sonata, Op. 168, 1st and 2nd movements

Day 1 is dedicated to solo auditions with piano accompaniment. Selected applicants will day 2 make an ensemble audition (music scores are distributed in advance).
